- **J. Orin Edson Family Lewy Body Dementia Center** focuses on the second-leading cause of dementia, which is often misdiagnosed. Families tend to have a difficult time finding the care and support they need for Dementia with Lewy Bodies and Parkinson's Disease with Dementia. The Lewy Body Dementia Center and Parkinson's program at BAI includes comprehensive diagnostic and medical care and access to clinical trials. Family services and neuro-wellness programs provide education, support, exercise, and wellness programming to meet the comprehensive needs of patients and families.

Arizona has the fastest growth rate for Alzheimer's disease in the nation, with a projected 33% increase in older adults living with Alzheimer's dementia between now and 2025, placing a strain on our health care systems, programs, and families.

BAI - Tucson is a centralized resource dedicated to addressing the growing demand for Alzheimer's care, education and support for Southern Arizona patients and their families. Services include:

- **Diagnosis and Treatment.** Each new patient receives a 90-minute initial evaluation. Once a diagnosis is made, physicians explain the findings and develop an individualized treatment plan that is shared with the patient, family members and the referring physician.

- **Support Programs.** A variety of support groups and programs are available to enhance the quality of life of patients and their care partners. For the community at large, the Memory Center offers memory screenings and educational sessions on maintaining and improving brain health.

- **Online Education.** Caregivers can get support and training from the comfort of home. The Dementia Dialogue monthly webinar series covers timely topics to help caregivers learn what to expect as the disease progresses and how to cope with issues that may arise.



- **Research.** Patients have access to the newest and best treatments available through the Institute's clinical trials program, where scientific studies aim to address the mechanism of the disease and targets of therapeutic action. Banner Alzheimer's Institute is an international leader in the use of magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) and positron emission tomography (PET) imaging to measure the extent of Alzheimer's in the brain.
