At Banner Health, we understand that rehabilitation through compassionate, excellent care is important. Effective treatments are available for a wide array of injuries, conditions and disorders, including cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation, occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech therapy, sports and orthopedic therapy, and stroke rehabilitation.

The Rehabilitation Institute's inpatient therapy program features an accredited rehabilitation center with 63 beds and treats acquired brain injuries, orthopedic conditions, spinal cord injuries, limb loss, stroke and trauma. Additional program support will help expand the Institute's outpatient and inpatient services to assist more patients in returning to daily activities as quickly and safely as possible. **Services in need of philanthropic support include:**

Recreational Therapy

Banner – University Medical Center is the only program in the state with a recreational therapy program. Therapists utilize recreation and other activity-based interventions to assist the patients with transitioning back into community. This requires helping them cope, adapt, and work through the physical, psychological, and social aspects of their condition.

Brain Injury Rehabilitation Center

The Rehabilitation Institute is home to the internationally recognized Brain Injury Rehabilitation Center, which provides integrative therapies for individuals with traumatic and acquired brain injuries. Patients receive highly specialized services aimed at promoting functional independence and recovery.



Patient Assistance

Disabling injury or illness does not distinguish between rich and poor, but effective treatment is expensive—and the burden often falls on patients with limited resources.
