

Volunteer Opportunities with Banner Health

Every year, thousands of people serve as Banner Health volunteers, helping people in emergencies, raising funds for equipment and services, donating blood, organizing programs for the elderly and young children, and more. Volunteers are an important part of Banner Health's mission to make health care easier, so life can be better.

Banner Health is in need of a wide variety of supplies for our patients. Groups can organize a drive, collecting goods and then delivering them to our medical centers. Needs include:

School Supplies. Gather and deliver coloring books, crayons, markers, paper, glue, crafting fabric and pencils to a Banner Children's medical center for pediatric patients in our Hospital School program.

Toys. Toys (tech toys included) comfort young patients staying in our Banner Children's medical centers and in our pediatric emergency departments.

Books & Magazines. Gather and deliver new books and magazines for patients.

Clothing. Clothing is needed for adolescent/teenage patients at Banner Behavioral Health Hospital, who are often admitted without many personal items.

Cancer Patient "Comforts." Collect and deliver new comfort items including blankets, puzzles, games, and gentle personal care items for cancer patients.

Hygiene Kits. Assemble and deliver personal hygiene kits (shampoo, toothbrushes, toothpaste, bars of soap, combs, etc.) for homeless individuals who visit our emergency departments.

Get Well Cards. Make "Get Well Soon" cards for patients and deliver to Banner Casa Grande Medical Center.
